- the classical ensemble of the Senate Square and around it with all the main historical and cultural places of Helsinki
- Suomenlinna, a sea fortress, 1748 built UNESCO Heritage center island ship visit
- The unique church in the Rock*
- Beautiful architecture of Finnish national romanticism style (18-19th centuries)
- Famous monument to Finnish composer Jean Sibelius
- Worldwide award-winning Oodi library
- Parliament building
- National Museum of Finland*

In the Old Town of Tallinn, Estonia, you'll be able to see

- Toompea Castle — the residence of the viceroys of kings, governors of Estonia, Parliament*
- The Dome Cathedral - the one of the oldest churches in Tallinn,
- Two observation decks offering a magnificent view of the Old Town.
- The garden of the Danish King — one of the most romantic places in Tallinn
- The Church of St. Nicholas (Niguliste)*
- The Town Hall Square with The Town Hall itself and the oldest Town Hall Pharmacy in Europe
- The Church of the Holy Spirit and the building of the Great Guild*
- The oldest Orthodox Church in Estonia, founded by Yaroslav the Wise and the Alexander Nevsky Orthodox Cathedral
- The only Catholic Church of the Holy Apostles Peter and Paul in the Old Town
- The ruins of the Dominican monastery*
- Katarina Lane with its various open studios which function as everyday workrooms for the artists.
- The fortress wall
- The Virussky Gate.

In Stockholm, the capital of Scandinavia as Swedes call it you'll be able to see

- The Old city (Gamla Stan)
- Cosy marina along Ostermalm district
- The view from the rocks of Södermalm district to the panorama of the Old city, Archipelago, Modern museum and the Grona lund
- The Royal palace*

- The Royal Djurgarden - the home to Stockholm's top attractions, but also a massive green oasis where the locals feed their need for nature.
- The Stockholm City Hall where the Nobel Prize banquet is held each year*
- Nobel museum*
- Vasa museum - the world's only preserved 17th century ship*
- Skansen -the world's first open-air museum*
- Abba the museum*
- Swedish metro as a part of Swedeish Art*
- the Grona Lund - Stockholm's amusement park that overlooks the water*
- Junibacken - the museum of Astrid Lindgren's books*
- Fotografiska - the photo museum*
- Spiritmuseum*
